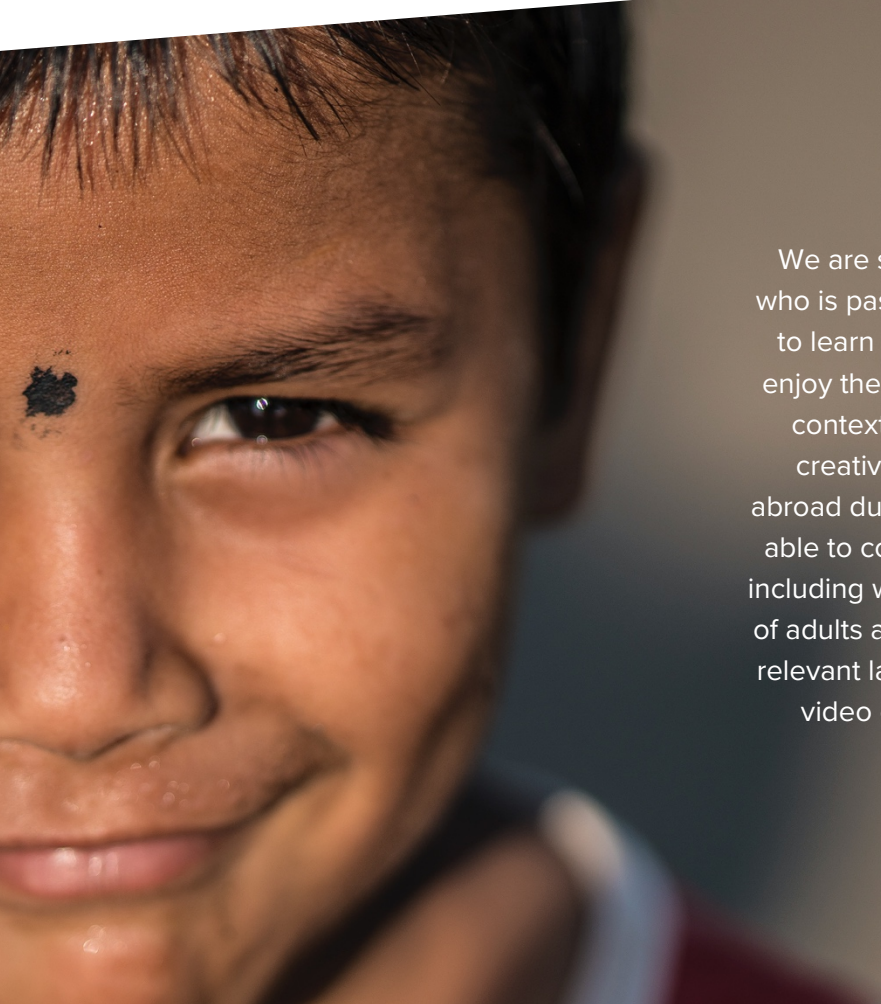
WHO?

AsiaLink

We are a Christian mission organisation based in the UK. Our team are passionate about reaching the unreached people of Asia in a variety of ways, but primarily through the provision of Scripture and the training and support of native workers who know the language and understand the culture of those they seek to reach.

You

We are seeking an eager and enthusiastic intern who is passionate about world mission, who desires to learn more about gospel ministry and who will enjoy the challenge of applying that learning to the context in Asia. You will need to be organised, creative and ready to serve both at home and abroad during the year. You must also be willing and able to communicate our work in a variety of ways, including written articles and presentations to groups of adults and young people. Additional skills such as relevant languages, graphic design, photography or video editing are beneficial but not essential.



HOW?

Training

We will support you through an excellent ministry training course run by the North West Partnership, as well as providing additional input specific to overseas mission and the need in Asia.

Ministry Experience

You will have a unique opportunity to explore some of our projects first-hand through visits to the field, culminating in the chance to co-lead a team of young adults in summer 2022*. You will also have opportunities to present the work of AsiaLink at church meetings and/or other groups.

Spiritual Formation

We will actively support and encourage your personal spiritual growth throughout the year. This will take place through a combination of training, personal mentoring, conferences, a staff retreat and a reading programme.

Practical Service

You will assist with day-to-day activities, including administrative tasks, communication with supporters and some input into creative and strategic decisions. The goal is to give you an overview of the whole organisation, including finance, communications, regional representation and central management.



WHY?

Around 3 billion people in the world today remain unreached by the gospel, and over 75% of them live in Asia. They have no Bible, no local church and no Christian witness. The AsiaLink Internship is one of the many ways in which we are seeking to engage people in the UK with Asia's immense need for the gospel.



WHERE?

The internship will be primarily based at our office in Northwich, with occasional travel to other locations. You will spend some time in our Ireland office and there will be opportunities to travel to our projects in Asia throughout the year*. Travel expenses will be covered.

WHEN?

The internship will start on 1st September 2021 and will last for one year.

OTHER DETAILS

Hours and pay

The successful applicant will be expected to work 3 days per week, with the other 2 days set aside to attend a training course and to study. A basic salary will be paid and any reasonable expenses incurred will also be reimbursed.

Most work will take place Monday to Friday within usual office hours, but occasional weekend and evening work will be required.

Other benefits

The role includes paid annual leave, pension contributions and sick pay.
