We are seeking a highly driven individual who is eager to inspire churches and individuals to engage with God's work in Asia. As a vital part of our UK team, you will be responsible for creating and developing relationships with churches and individuals across the north of England and in Wales.

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintain and develop relationships with supporting churches across the north of England and in Wales.
- Pro-actively engage new churches with the work of AsiaLink across the region and in other geographical areas where appropriate.
- Conduct occasional visits to project partners in Asia to learn about their ministry and provide supportive fellowship.
- Give regular presentations on the work of AsiaLink to churches and other groups in the UK, based on first-hand experiences gained on the field. This may include Christian Unions, youth groups and more. Frequent domestic travel will be required, with evening and weekend work forming a significant part of the role. Some overnight stays will be required.
- Basic administrative and finance tasks as required.
- Contribute to Christian fellowship within the team during staff prayer meetings, team days and retreats.
