


NEPAL WAYS TO PRAY



Nepal claims to be a secular state, but with Hindus making up over 83% of the population, the government is strongly influenced in this direction. Tibetan Buddhism is prevalent in the Himalayan region in the north of the country.

In 2017 the Nepali government introduced anti-conversion laws forbidding anyone to convert from one religion to another. Since the introduction of these new laws, opponents of Christianity have targeted the work of evangelism and church planting in Nepal.

ONE

There are just over 29 million people in Nepal, over 90% of whom are considered unreached by the gospel.

Please pray for the church in this land where it is now illegal to evangelise or to disturb the religion of other people.

TWO

Nepal has 285 people groups, of which 275 remain unreached. Many are living in remote inaccessible parts of the Himalayas and the western mountains. Of the 65 languages spoken in Nepal, only 13 have the complete Bible.

Pray for the ongoing translation work in other languages.

THREE

Hindus make up over 80% of the population in Nepal. Despite being nominally secular, the government is strongly influenced in favour of this majority. Buddhism receives special recognition as well.

Pray for our Christian brothers and sisters who are living out their faith in this hostile context.

XI2

One evangelist supported through the Beautiful Feet Project often travels by jeep into the mountains and rural districts sharing the gospel.

Ask God to lead, guide and protect him as he distributes literature and preaches in remote villages. Pray that many will give their lives to Christ.

FOUR

A number of Tharu people in southeastern Nepal have come to Christ and groups of believers are gathering in several remote villages. They have recently received the gospel of John, the first portion of Scripture available in their heart language.

Pray that God would continue to build His church among the Tharu.

SEVEN

Evangelists and church leaders face pressure and hardship as they serve in the needy mission field of Nepal.

Pray that the Lord would help and protect these servants and their families so that all their practical and spiritual needs will be met. Pray that they would remain fresh in their own spiritual lives and stay close to God.

FIVE

Our partners in Nepal organise pastor training seminars throughout the country. Evangelists and church planters travel from remote areas to gather for a few days of bible teaching.

Pray that they will benefit from the time of fellowship and be better equipped to serve in their churches.
